Dear Commissioner Fox:

I am writing to express my deep concerns about a grade crossing at Midland Avenue in Elmwood Park, New Jersey and to request that the State of New Jersey dedicate resources to improve the safety at this intersection. I would ask that my office be given a briefing on the history of safety issues at this crossing, the improvements that have been made to date, and any plans that have been made to address this issue moving forward.

The Federal Railroad Administration's Accident Prediction System, as reported by *The New York Times*, has determined that the crossing where the New Jersey Transit Bergen County commuter rail line crosses Midland Avenue as the single most dangerous intersection in the Tri-State area. There have been a record 29 accidents at this crossing in the past 40 years, resulting in two deaths and six injuries. Looking back, it seems that every several months there is a new story in *The Record* about a commuter train hitting a car at this crossing. These accidents become more alarming in light of the tragic event in Westchester on the Metro-North system earlier this month. I would like to work with your department to find a permanent solution to this grave public safety issue.

As you know, under MAP-21, the federal government provides funding, albeit limited, to states through the Highway-Railway Crossing Program. New Jersey was allocated \$2.4 Million for this purpose in fiscal year 2015. I would urge that these dollars, in addition to other eligible federal,

state, or New Jersey Transit programs, be directed towards making improvements to the grade crossing deemed most dangerous to the traveling public.
